I traded a Ford Bronco for the paint job (I should have kept it until I got my car back; it took over a year). The strange thing about the car is that it has a column shift. I have a factory his and hers shifter and the correct steering column all painted and ready to install but I haven't convinced myself to do it yet. The car has map lights instead of the regular dome light and the original interior except for the carpet. The car runs fantastic and has a quiet rumble.

My future plans include adding front disc brakes, rebuilding the front suspension, new exhaust, adding factory electric windows and maybe putting in that shifter.




