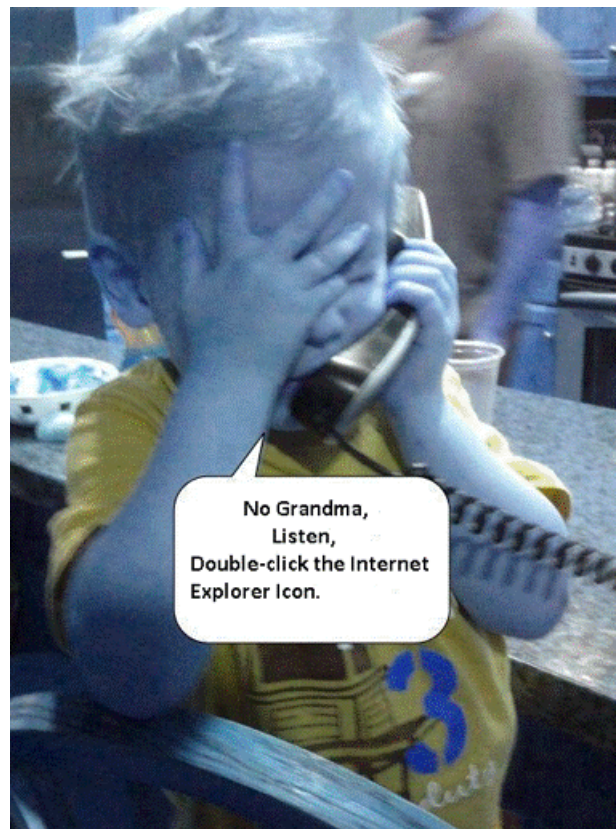
**CHRISTMAS PARTY !!!!!
